Instructions Front Control Arm Bushings

N.B: This instruction sheet should be used in conjunction with the workshop manual and proper safety procedures followed.

Raise vehicle evenly and safely support

Never rely on a Jack only

 Proceed to remove front wheels and un-bolt front arms.

Note - mark wheel alignment eccentrics with white marker before removing.

- Remove original rubber bushings. Use a Air-hacksaw to cut outer bushing shell or place a drill in the rubber - between inner steel tube and outer steel tube.
- Proceed to press new bushings 90230 into arm.

Note - soapy water can assist with popping into control arm.


- Grease bushing internal diameter and side face with supplied grease only.
- Push in supplied steel tubes
- Re-fit arms to vehicle.


